

Ordering conditions Alpenbrevet clothing collection

- 1. Tremola by Night on August 29, 2026**
- 2. Alpenbrevet Event on September 5, 2026**

With the purchase of articles from the Alpenbrevet clothing collection, all buyers agree to the following ordering conditions:

1. Tremola by Night

Orders relating to the Tremola by Night event will be delivered exclusively by post and are subject to a charge.

Ordering	Delivery
Between 01.01. – 31.03.2026	During June 2026
Between 01.04. – 30.06.2026	Latest until mid August

The shipping costs are calculated as follows:

- Shipping costs within Switzerland CHF 13.00
- International shipping costs CHF 25.00*

2. Alpenbrevet

In general, each buyer can choose between sending the order by post, subject to a charge, or collecting the order from the Swiss Cycling Alpenbrevet event location in Andermatt.

The following conditions apply to the postal delivery of the order:

Ordering	Delivery
Between 13.09. – 31.12.2025	During March 2026
Between 01.01. – 31.03.2026	During June 2026
Between 01.04. – 30.06.2026	Latest until the 05.09.2026
From 01.07.2026	Latest until the 05.09.2026 (only stock articles)

The shipping costs are calculated as follows:

- Shipping costs within Switzerland CHF 13.00
- International shipping costs CHF 25.00*

If the buyer does not choose a shipping method, the following conditions apply to the collection of the order in Andermatt:

- For the buyer it is a matter of a debt to collect the order
- The order can be collected from the Alpenbrevet event location in Andermatt (CH) on Friday, 4 September 2026 and Saturday, 5 September 2026

In case of uncollected orders, the following conditions apply:

- Buyers will be informed by e-mail after Alpenbrevet 2026 that their order has not yet been collected.
- From the date of sending this e-mail, buyers have 30 days to pay the shipping costs of CHF 13.00 (Switzerland) or CHF 25.00 (abroad) in advance and the order will then be sent to them by post.
- If no payment or other feedback is received within these 30 days, the ordered goods will be donated to charity without refund of the purchase price.

There is no legal time limit for keeping the ordered goods for a longer period. The contract of sale constitutes a two-sided legal transaction. The buyer has the obligation to pay and the seller has the obligation to hand over the goods. The buyer has a legal obligation to accept the goods; the acceptance must take place immediately (at the event location of the Swiss Cycling Alpenbrevet in Andermatt).

* When shipping abroad, customs duties may be incurred, which must be paid by the buyer.
